
Coniferous Trees




- Broad flat leaves








Birch Gree

Maple is an expensive wood and is very light in colour.




The wood of the scots pine is a light brown-cream Colours with a distinct grain. It is known as red deal and is a strong softwood. The wood is easy to work with and finished well.





Elm is a decideous tree that belongs to the family Ulmaceae.

It is sometimes called the Oregon pine or Colombian pine. It grow quickly and is tall.


The wood is a reddish - brown colour.
